BUILDING OPERATIONS

Reception Open Hours - Monday to Friday, 10:00—12 noon and 1:00—2:00 p.m. Outside these hours, please call (416)247-5316.

Mask Wearing in Common Areas - The City has mandated the wearing of masks in all common areas inside apartment buildings. Please let your visitors know that they must wear a mask. We recognize that some cannot wear a mask because of a medical condition. Physical distancing of 6 feet or 2 metres must still be maintained.

Parking - All residents must park in resident designated parking spaces, not visitor spaces. Visitors to Clement need to park in visitor spaces in the west portion of the Clement parking lot, not in the Kipling lot.

Please do not remove or move furniture and décor - Chairs and tables should not be moved. Pictures and other items must remain in place and not be removed.

Continued Closure of Non-Essential Common Areas - The City of Toronto has mandated that all non-essential common areas remain closed until October 31, 2020. Extra disinfection will continue.

Update on new lease for 105 Clement Road - Both the church and the Foundation Board are working on finalizing the new lease for the 105 Clement Road building which rests on land owned by the church. The new lease will allow for the Foundation to continue to operate the Clement building.

City Water Shut Off—August 21st from 10:00 to 4:00 p.m. - Please set some water aside and ensure taps are turned off.

Dining Room - The dining service will continue as “take out only” while non-essential common areas are closed. We have scheduled two more barbeques for August 28th and September 15th. Patio barbeque lunches are served from the Clement Coffee Shop. Please maintain physical distancing. A take out Saturday Roast Beef dinner is scheduled for Saturday, September 5th. Please call (416)247-5316, ext. 29 by August 31st and leave your name to reserve if you want to pick up a dinner on Sept. 5th.
